


# TRAVELER *sire line*



**Traveler Sire Line:** QAS Traveler 23-4 is the best-known son of Band 234 of Ideal 3163 ("Band 105"). A 2017 Angus Foundation-funded research project revealed that "Traveler" was the most influential sire in the Angus breed, as measured by either Marginal or Co-ancestry Contribution. His genetics make up about 10% of Angus animals born today. (Band 105 accounts for 6.3% by Coancestry Contribution.) QAS Traveler 23-4 was the first direct son of Band 105 to have a major impact on the Angus breed, and his daughters in AHIR (almost 9,000) post a combined 101 WW ratio. QAS Traveler 23-4 produced numerous sons who have had a tremendous positive influence on the Jorgensen herd and the entire Angus breed.
